This Memorandum of Understanding is executed on 11/02/2021 through the Chief functionaries of the parties.



I. The Govt. J.Yoganandam Chhattisgarh College, is a prestigious autonomous college committed over eight decades (established in 1938) to disseminate knowledge in the faculty of Arts, Commerce, Science, and Law. It was on 16th July 1938 under the banner of Chhattisgarh Education Society and through the efforts of an eminent academician, Late Shri. J. Yoganandam that the college took shape of an institution of higher education.

The college was established with undergraduate classes in Arts and Commerce. Since its inception, it has fulfilled the vision to produce intellectually alert, morally upright, socially committed and economically self-reliant youth. At the time of the establishment of the college in Raipur, it was a part of the State of Central Provinces and Berar. In 1956, it became a part of the State of Madhya Pradesh, which in turn in 2000 became the capital of the newly created State of Chhattisgarh. In 1938, the college was affiliated to Nagpur University and finally in 1965 got affiliated to Pt. Ravishankar University, Raipur.

Similarly, the name of the college was changed from Govt. Chhattisgarh P.G.College to Govt. J.Yoganandam Chhattisgarh College as an honor to its founder Principal Shri. J.Yoganandam by the State Government on 13.06.2008. On 14th December 1996, the college was granted the status of a Post-Graduation college. Thereafter, in 1996, the college was recognized as an Autonomous College by the State Govt. and UGC.

The college which began with 10 students in 1938 has at present 3281 students. The alumni of the college have achieved prestigious positions in the society as renowned politicians, editors, police officers, administrators, etc.

The institution is situated in the centre of the city in a campus of approximately 3.5 acres. The college has a magnificent building situated in a lush green, eco-friendly campus with a playground. II. This University is unique in nature relatively to the other universities since its assignment is to promote excellence in teacher education and produce dynamic and smart teachers for the benefit of the society and the nation at large, with six Departments of Study and Research, namely: Department of Pedagogical Sciences, Department of Value Education, Department of Educational Psychology, Department of Educational Technology, Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation and Department of Educational Planning and Administration. Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University produces M.Ed., M.Phil., and PhD Scholars every year through the University Departments as well as through its affiliated Colleges of Education in Tamil Nadu.

1. Purpose and Objectives:

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment of the teachers. Hence, the parties desired to work together with the following objectives:

- 1.4. *To establish a global platform for the students and teachers.*
- 1.5. *To strengthen the educational relationships between ^{to}the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and Govt. J. Yoganandam Chhattisgarh College, Raipur-492001, for the welfare of the students and teachers.*

2. Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

- 2.1 *That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Registrar of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and Principal of Govt. J. Yoganandam Chhattisgarh College, Raipur-492001*
- 2.2 *That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions.*





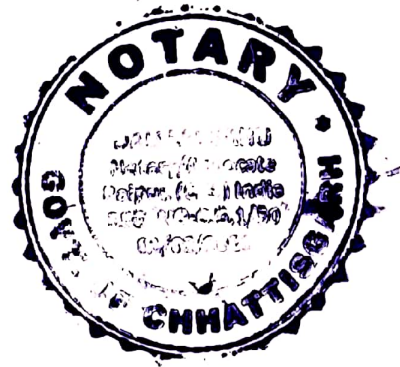

1.4 To encourage and emphasize the Professors, Associate Professors and others to participate and contribute as a resource faculty.


1.5 To establish a regional platform for the students/teachers.







Preamble

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by and between Govt. J. Yoganandam Chhattisgarh College, RAIPUR (Chhattisgarh) -492001 and M/s Siddhachalam Laboratory, (Chhattisgarh) Raipur-493221

This Memorandum of Understanding (here-in-after call as the 'MoU') is executed on 31. JANUARY.2023 by and between-

(1) **Govt. J. Yoganandam Chhattisgarh College, Raipur 492001 (C.G.)** represented by the principal (here-in-after referred to as 'First Party') the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the extent shall be deemed to mean and include its successors in-office, administrators and assignees.

AND

(2) **M/s Siddhachalam Laboratory** at P.C. No. 101, KH.No. 219/17, RING ROAD No 2, BIRGAON, Raipur, Chhattisgarh, 493221 (C.G.) represented by Dr. Bhawana Jain (here-in-after referred to as 'Second Party') which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the extent shall be deemed to mean and include its successors and assignees.

WHEREAS, the first party Govt. J. Yoganandam Chhattisgarh College, Raipur is an academic institution running the streams like science, arts, commerce and law cooperating the students to gain the practical knowledge and know how, skills-based training, education and research that can be part of their curriculum etc.

AND WHEREAS, the second party M/S Siddhachalam Laboratory is a technical laboratory for research engaged in water quality testing like pH value, chloride content, Salinity content, dissolved oxygen content, Turbidity test, Nitrate and Phosphate, pesticides, redox, electrical conductivity test etc. water treatment plan and process to filter and purify water and usable for human beings. The second party M/S Siddhachalam Laboratory organises time to time short term training programmes for synthesis of Nanomaterials/Nanocomposites and their multiple applications, synthesis of metal oxides, synthesis of non-metal oxides and reduced

graphite oxide, antibacterial and antifungal studies of nanomaterials, dye removal, study of catalytic properties etc.

AND WHEREAS, both the parties believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of their resources by the students thereby the students will have enhanced opportunities.

AND WHEREAS, the parties hereto are desirous of reducing into writing the terms and conditions of their oral joint commitment in order to avoid any dispute, differences or misunderstanding in future.

1) **Purpose and Objectives:**

To provide a platform to the teachers, the Research Scholars and the students of the faculty of science (Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Physics, Geography and Mathematics) of the college so that their laboratory needs and demands can be met. The budding graduates from the institution can play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2) **Co-Operation:**

To foster collaboration, to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best efforts and frequent interaction between both the parties regarding projects and skill development programmes for the students. The first party hereby agrees to add the skill development programmes into its academic syllabi for the students. This skill development programme will be as optional subject for those students, who are interested to participate in testing and research.

3) **Curriculum Design:**

The second party will give valuable inputs to the first Party in teaching/training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully facilitating job opportunities immediately after becoming graduates.

Projects:

If the First/second party will design a suitable project for the students and the same will incorporate into the syllabus of the academic semesters then there will be two Coordinators, first from the particular subject of First Party and the second from the second Party.

In case a student or scholar of the First Party voluntarily joins a project sponsored by the second Party, then the second party will be the coordinator of that project and First Party will have no responsibility for any issue.

5) **Training/Internship Programmes:**

The second party will communicate with the Industries and share an insight of the latest developments / requirements of the industries. The Second party will also provide internship / training facility to the students / scholars of the first party in the laboratory, under which the students/scholars will be given hands-on training for various types of analysis, synthesis and treatment procedures. The Second party will permit the Faculties and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies, Laboratory, Workshop and Industrial sites for learning and training. Industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this MoU will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career.

6) **Cost of Testing and Training/internship Programmes:**

The second party will charge an amount from the students towards Internship/skill development training programmes designed and organized by the second party. To finalize the cost of Internship/skill development training programmes the second party will take prior written consent from the first party and provide subsidized rates for the students / research scholars of the First Party.

7) **Guest Lectures:**

The second party will deliver guest lectures for skill development, practical training, internship, curricular activities without any charges.

Research Facilities:

Second party has well equipped laboratory with instruments required to carry out PhD research work smoothly for first party students/scholars. List of instruments available at Siddhachalam Laboratory are: UV-Visible Spectrophotometer(Shimadzu1900), pH meter (Systronics), Conductivity meter (Systronics), Turbidity meter(Systronics), TDS meter (Systronics), Ion selectometer (Thermofischer), Weigh machine with four point calibration (Aczet), Ultra-Sonicator (Patel Scientific), Magnetic stir, Centrifuge, Distillation assembly, Soxhlet for solvent extraction, Laminar Air flow, Bacterial Incubator, Hot plate, Microscope, Bacterial Colony Counter, Hot air oven (Biotechnica), Muffle Furnace (Patel Scientific), Vacuum Oven (Patel Scientific), Flame

Photometer (Systronics), COD Digester (Biotechnica), BOD incubator (Biotechnica), Computer, Printer, Scanner, Glasswares, and Chemicals.

Certification:

Further, the intellectual property rights that arise as a result of any collaborative research or activity under this MoU will be worked out on a case-by-case basis, and will be consistent with the officially laid down IPR policies of the two institutions.

11) Tenure and Termination:

That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties.

.....विश्वविद्यालयों और कॉलेजों के शिक्षण संकाय और अनुसंधान विद्वान / केंद्र और राज्य सरकार के विभागों / निगमों / बोर्डों आदि के अधिकारी / अनुसंधान और प्रशिक्षण संस्थान के अधिकारी / भारत के एक पंजीकृत सार्वजनिक ट्रस्ट / एक स्वतंत्र शोधकर्ता जिसे इसके बाद "प्रस्तावक संस्थान" कहा जाएगा
जो विकास उन्मुख अध्ययन को निष्पादित करने के लिए अनिवार्य है।

लक्ष्य और उद्देश्य

दोनों पक्ष प्रधान अन्वेषक के माध्यम से यह अध्ययन जिसका राज्य और इसके लोगों की संवृद्धि एवं विकास के दृष्टिकोण से परिवर्तनकारी एवं क्रियान्वयन महत्व (Transformational and Translational significance) है, संपादित करने के उद्देश्य से इस समझौता ज्ञापन (एमओयू) पर हस्ताक्षर करने पर सहमत हैं।

एमओयू का स्कोप

अब यह विलेख दोनों पक्षों के बीच निम्नानुसार सहमति का साक्ष्य है -

एसपीसी इस योजना के तहत अध्ययनकर्ता द्वारा प्रस्तुत अध्ययन प्रस्ताव के आधार पर अध्ययनकर्ता को उपरोक्त प्रस्तावक संस्थान के माध्यम से वित्तीय सहायता प्रदान करेगा। एसपीसी द्वारा इसकी प्रयोज्यता और उपयोगिता के लिए प्रस्ताव की विधिवत समीक्षा की गई है एवं इस अध्ययन प्रस्ताव के स्वीकृति हेतु सहमति व्यक्त की गई है। प्रस्तावक संस्थान इस अध्ययन प्रस्ताव को पूर्ण करने हेतु प्रधान अन्वेषक को एवं एसपीसी को अपेक्षित सहयोग प्रदान करने हेतु सहमत है।

समझौता ज्ञापन की अवधि

यह समझौता ज्ञापन स्वीकृत अध्ययन अवधि के लिए वैध होगा जिसका उल्लेख एसपीसी द्वारा जारी आदेश में किया जाएगा।

एसपीसी की जिम्मेदारियां

- अध्ययन आदि के प्रस्ताव को स्वीकार करना, परीक्षण करना, स्वीकृति देना और स्वीकृत निधि जारी करना।

प्रस्तावक संस्थान की जिम्मेदारियां


- एसपीसी द्वारा जारी स्वीकृति आदेश में उल्लेखित उद्देश्यों के अनुसार समय सीमा के भीतर अध्ययन को पूर्ण किये जाने की दिशा में अपेक्षित प्रगति सुनिश्चित करना।
- एसपीसी के आदेश/दिशा-निर्देश अनुसार प्रगति रिपोर्ट, अंतरिम रिपोर्ट, अंतिम रिपोर्ट और यथा आवश्यक प्रस्तुतीकरण प्रस्तुत किया जाना सुनिश्चित करना।
- एसपीसी से प्राप्त अनुदान से कय की गई परिसंपत्तियों एवं अभिलेखों/साहित्यों का दिशा निर्देश अनुसार संधारण।
- एसपीसी को उपयोगिता प्रमाण पत्र, वाउचर, व्यय विवरण प्रस्तुत करना और किसी भी अव्ययित राशि की वापसी।

नियम और शर्तें

- अनुदान की पहली किस्त अध्ययन हेतु स्वीकृत अनुदान राशि का 40 प्रतिशत होगी जो स्वीकृति आदेश के जारी होने के बाद प्रधान अन्वेषक को प्रदाय करने के लिए संस्था प्रमुख को जारी किया जाएगा।
- संस्था प्रमुख से प्रथम अंतरिम रिपोर्ट, अनुदान की पहली किस्त का व्यय विवरण एवं उपयोगिता प्रमाण पत्र प्राप्त होने पर द्वितीय किस्त की राशि कुल स्वीकृत अनुदान राशि का 30 प्रतिशत योजना दिशा-निर्देशों के अनुसार संस्था प्रमुख को जारी किया जायेगा।
- अध्ययन का अंतिम रिपोर्ट प्रस्तावक संस्था से अभिमत सहित सदस्य सचिव को प्राप्त होने के उपरान्त निम्नलिखित औपचारिकताएं पूर्ण किये जाने के उपरांत शेष 30 प्रतिशत की राशि अंतिम किस्त के रूप में जारी की जा सकेगी:-

मूल्यांकन समिति के समक्ष प्रस्तुत किया जाएगा और उनके सुझावों को यथासंभव शामिल किया जाएगा। अंतिम रिपोर्ट पर्याप्त रूप से व्यापक होना चाहिए जिससे वह रिकार्ड में रखे जाने के उद्देश्य को पूरा कर सके। निम्नलिखित दस्तावेजों के साथ राज्य योजना आयोग को एग्जीक्यूटिव समरी और सुझावों के साथ अंतिम रिपोर्ट भेजना अनिवार्य है :


- अध्ययन की अंतिम रिपोर्ट की 5 प्रतियां(हार्ड कॉपी) एवं सॉफ्ट कॉपी।

- निर्धारित प्रारूप में संपूर्ण अध्ययन अवधि के दौरान किए गए व्यय का रागेकित्त मददार विस्तृत विवरण, अध्ययनकर्ता द्वारा विधिवत हस्ताक्षरित और मुहरबंद।
- अध्ययन में किये गये वार्षिक व्यय के लिए निर्धारित प्रारूप में एक रागेकित्त लेखा परीक्षित उपयोगिता प्रमाणपत्र, चार्टर्ड एकाउंटेंट, प्रधान अन्वेषक एवं संस्था प्रमुख द्वारा विधिवत हस्ताक्षरित और मुहरबंद।
- अनुदान का अप्रयुक्त भाग, यदि कोई हो, एनईएफटी/आरटीजीएस/डिमांड ड्राफ्ट (सादस्य सचिव, राज्य योजना आयोग के पक्ष में तैयार) के माध्यम से तुरंत वापस किया जाएगा।
- एसपीसी शासन के संबंधित विभागों के साथ अध्ययन के परिणामों को तथा रिपोर्ट को साझा और उपयोग कर सकती है। रिपोर्ट एसपीसी, प्रधान अन्वेषक और प्रस्तावक संस्थान की संयुक्त संपत्ति होगी।
- अध्ययन के पूरा होने के तुरंत बाद खातों का निपटान करने के लिए संस्थान जिम्मेदार होगा।
- रिपोर्ट का एग्जीक्यूटिव समरी, अध्ययन दस्तावेज, मोनोग्राफ, अकादमिक पत्र राज्य योजना आयोग की वेबसाइट पर प्रकाशित किए जा सकेंगे।
- अध्ययन हस्तांतरणीय नहीं है।
- यदि प्रधान अन्वेषक स्वीकृत आदेश में दी गयी समय सीमा के अन्दर अध्ययन को पूर्ण करने में असफल रहता है तो प्रस्तावक संस्थान एवं प्रधान अन्वेषक जारी की गई सम्पूर्ण राशि को ब्याज सहित वापस करने के लिए संयुक्त रूप से अथवा पृथक-पृथक उत्तरदायी होंगे।
- यदि प्रधान अन्वेषक को उसके मूल कार्यस्थल से किसी अन्य स्थान/संस्थान में स्थानांतरित किया जाता है, तो दोनों संस्थानों से अध्ययन के हस्तांतरण के लिए अनापत्ति प्रमाण पत्र प्रस्तुत किया जाना चाहिए, जिसमें यह स्पष्ट रूप से उल्लेखित होगा कि स्वीकृत अध्ययन के सुचारु संचालन के लिए प्रधान अन्वेषक का जिस संस्थान में स्थानान्तरण होता है उस संस्थान द्वारा आवश्यक सुविधाएं प्रदान की जाएंगी।


विवाद का निपटारा

- इस समझौता ज्ञापन के किसी भी प्रावधान की व्याख्या और/या कार्यान्वयन और/या लागू करने के संबंध में किसी भी मतभेद या विवाद को आपसी परामर्श या दोनों पक्षों के बीच बातचीत के माध्यम से सौहार्द्रपूर्ण ढंग से सुलझाया जाएगा। मतभेद या विवाद के संबंध में आपसी परामर्श/बातचीत से निर्णय न हो पाने की स्थिति में माननीय उपाध्यक्ष, राज्य योजना आयोग का निर्णय अंतिम एवं दोनों पक्षों पर बाध्यकारी होगा।
- इस अध्ययन के संपादन के दौरान किसी भी फील्ड स्टाफ, अध्ययनकर्ता या किसी अन्य व्यक्ति की मृत्यु, चोट या किसी कानूनी कार्रवाई से उत्पन्न होने की स्थिति में स्वयं की संस्था के स्टाफ को छोड़कर अन्य किसी भी स्टाफ की देनदारी के लिए कोई भी पक्ष जिम्मेदार नहीं होगा।



समझौता ज्ञापन पर हस्ताक्षर

- अ) दोनों पक्ष इसके उद्देश्यों और उद्देश्यों की भावना में इस समझौता ज्ञापन को निश्चित करने के लिए सहमत हैं।


